

Remembering Our Heritage

Opal Lee (1926-) is a retired teacher, counselor, and activist in the movement to make Juneteenth (July 19) a federal-recognized holiday commemorating the day the enslaved in Texas found out that they had been freed two and half years before in 1863. Juneteenth is the "Emancipation Day" or "Freedom Day" recognized and celebrated primarily by African Americans. Opal Lee is often described as the "grandmother of Juneteenth". On June 17, 2021; President Joe Biden signed Senate Bill S.475, making Juneteenth the eleventh federal holiday. President Biden said in a press conference "Great nations don't ignore their most painful moments, they embrace them." On Friday, May 3, 2024 along with 18 other recipients, Opal Lee was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom which is this nation's highest civilian honor by President Joe Biden.
