

Remembering Our Heritage



Let Us Break Bread Together

The roots of this song were probably formed in the slave culture that developed in South-Eastern colonial America's coastal areas such as South Carolina, St. Helena Island, Charleston, and Beaufort. *Let Us Break Bread Together* is a call for Christians to come together,

whether knelt or stood and celebrate the Lord's Supper. Let Us Break Bread Together has been subject to numerous alterations as can be seen in different hymnals and cultures. John Rosamond Johnson (1873-1954) arranged the first solo version with the three stanzas that are common to most hymnals in the U.S. This version of the spiritual was popularized by notable African American soloists in the mid-twentieth century such as Paul Robeson, Roland Hayes, and Marian Anderson.
